Enrollment & Enrollment Projections

The District's current enrollment is 3749. Projections for 2024-2025 enrollment were provided by school. The District is receiving some intake of students from Aquin.

Attendance Data

As a District our average daily attendance for April was 90.51%, the state average is 92.50%

ACT Testing to Return in IL Schools

Beginning next spring, high school Jr's in IL will move back to taking the ACT vs. the SAT.

Summer Learning Updates

Elementary (K-6): 500+ students enrolled. All students will receive reading, math, and enrichment opportunities. The students will also be provided with educational and fun field trips.

Middle School (7-8): 51 students enrolled. FMS will once again be offering summer learning through their mentoring program, which combines academics and social-emotional learning that will bring them into the community to learn about local businesses.

High School (9-12): 200 students at FHS will be taking advantage of credit recovery offerings as they work toward meeting high school graduation requirements. Many students will also be taking advantage of the summer driver's education program. S.I.T.E. (Banks-Bergagna) & Freeport Alternative HighSchool will also provide Summer programming.
