Superintendent Report

PreK Recognition: ExceleRate Illinois is anchored by a set of standards that focus on early learning and development and places a high priority on instructional excellence, family services, staff qualifications, professional development, and program administration. Central to its design is the recognition of multiple forms of evidence to meet the universal standards. Evidence is obtained through the monitoring visits conducted through National Louis University's contract with the Illinois State Board of Education.

The <u>Silver Circle of Quality</u> Silver Circle programs meet or exceed **specific** quality benchmarks on learning environment and instructional quality, along with **selected** administrative standards, qualifications, and professional development.(not all standards). Awarded to **Blackhawk and Empire Schools**.

The **Gold Circle of Quality** Gold Circle programs meet or exceed specific quality benchmarks on learning environment, instructional quality, and all administrative standards; group size and ratios; qualifications; and professional development. Awarded to **Center School and Lincoln Douglas**
