NATIONAL YOUTH HOMELESSNESS MONTH

Dear Families and FSD 145 Staff,

One of the crucial data points that I will be presenting at Tuesday's State of the District is the increase of homeless students in our district from 4.8% in 2023 to 7.5% in 2024. The McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance includes youth who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. This also includes students who are staying with friends or relatives due to economic hardship or in temporary living situations. Students without permanent housing have the right to enroll in school, even if we are not able to obtain any records. They have a right to receive transportation to and from their school of origin. Most of all, these students have a right to receive support for academic success.

Research from the University of Chicago tells us there is a significant relationship between educational attainment and homelessness, as homelessness is a risk factor for lower educational attainment. This makes the work of administrators, teachers and staff all the more important for our students who need and deserve all the wraparound services our district can provide. One of the services our district

provides is distributing gift cards to our McKinney Vento families for purchases of food, gas and personal items.

As the temperatures begin to drop and the spirit of the holiday season is upon us, I challenge us to support and uplift our most vulnerable students through the various means possible to bring them comfort and joy.


