#### **ATTENDANCE MATTERS!**



I want to continue to stress the importance of student attendance for the remainder of the second semester. We are seeing a downward trend in chronic absenteeism (missing 10% or more school days, excused or unexcused, which equates to 17+ days of absence), which is a good thing. I want to reiterate the fact that all our schools are focused on addressing how to improve student attendance through their school improvement plans.

At the end of the 2022-2023 school year, our chronic absenteeism rate was 37.2%. Currently, our overall rate on the 105th day of school is 28%. We will continue to do our part in working hard to keep students engaged and build important academic and social skills. However, schools cannot do this work alone. Therefore, I am once again reaching out to our families to help us get students to attend school regularly. Regular attendance helps build consistency in routines and more importantly, life skills that have greater implications towards the future or our students. Thank you for your ongoing partnership in this most important effort. Working together we will continue to decrease chronic absenteeism in our District.
